In the Triples:

Placings for the Championship are First, Second, Third and fourth
Placings for the Plate are First, Second and third equal
- Remaining 2 teams to play best of 3 to determine Bowl
Placings are First and Second only.

In the Doubles:

- After lunch Top 4 to play for Championship and next 4 to play for Consulante. Each 4 plays a semi-final and then the winners play a final.
Placings are First, Second, Third and Fourth in the Championship
Placings for the Consulante are First, Second and Third equal
- Next 4 to play for Plate and remaining players to play for the Bowl.
Each 4 plays a semi-final and then the winners play a final.
Placings are First, Second and 3rd equal.
